



Mountain Camp – Site Map

Mountain Camp is our largest centre, sleeping up to 192 people. The beds are mostly bunks, with some single beds available. All the rooms are carpeted, and have electric heating. We provide a pillow and one blanket on each bed. Groups using Mountain Camp need to provide linen, including a pillow slip, and a sleeping bag or blankets. Please remember that it can be cold in the mountains so please bring adequate bedding!

The large carpeted dining/meeting hall has an open wood fire, as well as gas heating. Also available in the hall is a small PA system, piano, overhead projector/screen, TV/DVD/Video player and whiteboard. A data projector is available for groups to hire, and a public phone is located near the men's toilets.

The large kitchen is equipped with a dishwasher, 3 large stoves/ovens, as well as a high volume toaster, bain marie, and griddle. Refrigeration, freezing and storage facilities suitable for large groups are provided. A separate tea and coffee preparation area in the hall contains a zip hot water heater and sink. An undercover BBQ is located just beside the dining room. We provide a table tennis table (with bats and balls) in the dining/meeting room and a variety of other basic sporting equipment is available for groups to use on our large oval across the road.

Groups may choose to self cater in Mountain Camp, or full catering is available. Groups choosing to self cater need to provide tea towels.

Bed configuration:

Rooms 16-22 and 27-33 have 10 beds

Rooms 9, 10, 14, 15 have 6 beds

The small room adjacent to the kitchen has 3 beds

Rooms 11-13 and 26 have 4 beds

Rooms 23-25 have 3 beds
